The Center in Hollywood is a nonprofit breaking the cycle of homelessness through radical hospitality, creating safe and supportive communities.



MOVE IN KITS

People need more than a key to create a home. Staff secure furniture and appliances for participants, but having a grab-n-go kit with household essentials helps individuals start their first month in their new home, with dignity.

General Relief does not cover basics. Individuals on GR receive about \$221 / month. This is supposed to cover partial rent, food, medications, clothes, transportation, phone, etc.

For many participants, they cannot spare a dollar on necessities for their apartment. That's where you come in!

Impact January - March 2021

Housing

- Staff moved **35 people** into permanent housing.
- Outreach helped **13 people** off the streets and into interim housing, putting them on the path to permanent homes.

Healthcare

- In the first quarter, staff coordinated **91 appointments** for clients with our partners from Saban Community Clinic
- Over **100 Moderna vaccinations** provided in partnership with LA County Department of Health Services

Food Security

- Monday - Thursday, we provide about **100 meals** to participants everyday.

COVID-19 Impact

- In 2019 the outreach team served **475 people**. In the first half of 2020 that increased to **1330 people**.

Fun Fact

We're well-known for our coffee hour. We provide a safe space for conversation that helps people engage with health and housing services.

MOVE IN KITS are about **\$150 each** but we can often offset with other donations.

They might include:

- **Kitchen Items** such as a dish set, drinkware, flatware, dish soap, dish towels, cooking utensils, trash bags.
- **Cleaning Supplies** including all-purpose cleaner, paper towels, sponges, hand soap, laundry detergent.
- **Bathroom Items** like a bath towel set, washcloths, shampoo, conditioner, toilet paper, toothbrush and toothpaste.
- **Other items** including a 60 quart bin for storage and to hold the kit, photo frame so individuals can hang a memory on a wall for the first time in a long time, a "welcome home" card written by you to let the person know they have someone thinking of them.
